

REPORT ON THE CONSTRUCTION OF HAKU COMMUNITY HALL

1. Project Description:

- i) Project Title: Community Hall in Haku
- ii) Project Type: Construction
- iii) Project Location: Haku, Rasuwa, Nepal
- iv) No. of beneficiaries of this Project: 635 people

2. Why is Community Hall needed?

95% of the village physical infrastructure was destroyed in the earthquake, including schools and health post.

Eighth months after the calamity the villagers of Haku remained dispersed in various camps for displaced in three districts of Nepal.

There was an urgent need for initiating reconstruction of the village and resuming the basic services.

3. Project's Objectives:

- i) Create a common space that will be used by the community for social purposes
- ii) Enable the locals to conduct any kind of community activities, such as trainings, orientation classes, meetings etc.
- iii) Provide temporary classrooms until the proper school is reconstructed
- iv) Provide shelter for village orphans who lost their parents
- v) Host the village health post

4. Location of Community Hall

The land was donated by Mr. Nhima Namgyal Sherpa and the location was selected by the villagers in the safest and most convenient place for all.

5. Project Implementation:

The building was constructed by the local volunteers in the period of 45 days thanks to the financial support of Focus for Nepal.

6. Total Project's Cost:

Rs. 12,40,023
